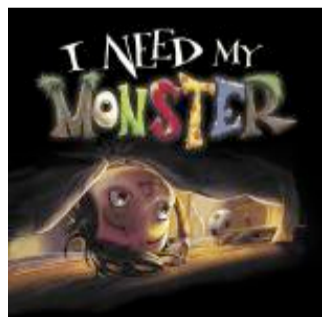
Hemingway Endorses "I Need My Monster"
